The included Statement of Common Core Beliefs expresses beliefs held with conviction as core to Limestone Christian Academy. We ask that this be considered with reverence and complete honesty. Statement of Common Core Beliefs

We, the legal guardians of the applicants here-in named, affirm that we hold the following beliefs, that our public and private lives reflect these beliefs, and we teach these to our children in our home.

- We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative, inerrant Word of God (2 Timothy 3:15; 2 Peter 1:21).
- We believe there is only one God, eternally existent in three persons—Father, Son and Holy Spirit (Genesis 1:1; Matthew 28:19; John 10:30).
- We believe in the deity of Christ (John 10:33); His virgin birth (Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:23; Luke 1:35); His sinless life (Hebrews 4:15; 7:26); His miracles (John 2:11); His vicarious and atoning death (1 Corinthians 15:3; Ephesians 1:7; Hebrews 2:9); His resurrection (John 11:25; 1 Corinthians 15:4); His ascension to the right hand of the Father (Mark 16:19); His personal return in power and glory (Acts 1:11; Revelation 19:11).
- We believe in the absolute necessity of regeneration by the Holy Spirit for salvation because of the exceeding sinfulness of human nature, and that men are justified on the single ground of faith in the shed blood of Christ and that only by God's grace and through faith alone we are saved (John 3:16-19; 5:24; Romans 3:23; 5:8-9; Ephesians 2:8-10; Titus 3:5).
- We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; they that are saved unto the resurrection of life, and they that are lost unto the eternal separation from God (John 5: 28-29).
- We believe that all human life is sacred and created by God in His image. Human life is of inestimable worth in all its dimensions, including pre-born babies, the aged, the physically or mentally challenged, and every other stage or condition from conception

through natural death. We are therefore called to defend, protect, and value human life. (Psalm 139)

- We believe that marriage is only between one man and one woman. God’s Word is clear that the two, meaning one man and one woman, become one flesh in marriage. (Gen 2:24; Matt 19:6; Mark 10:8)
- We believe that any form of sexual immorality (including adultery, fornication, homosexual behavior, bisexual conduct, bestiality, incest, and use of pornography) is sinful and offensive to God. (Matthew 15:18–20; 1 Corinthians 6:9–10.)

The school believes in the spiritual unity of the Body of Believers in our Lord Jesus Christ, no matter to which Bible-believing denomination or church they belong, ever seeking to become “more and more in every way like Christ, who is the head of His Body, the Church” (Ephesians 4:16).

Priority will be given to drawing all students to a personal salvation experience with Jesus Christ and to training them to live a selfless life that is pleasing to God, as revealed in His Word (John 12:32; Matthew 5:16).

We acknowledge that we hold the above beliefs and that if it becomes known that these beliefs are violated, Limestone Christian Academy will address the violation up to and including termination of family membership and enrollment of students.
